# **Description**

An acrylic protective finishing wax in an acrylic emulsion for Venetian plasters.

# **Recommended Use**

Interior commercial, hospitality, military, educational and residential applications; used in connection with PermaTone Walltextures.

#### Colors

Clear.

# **Packaging**

1 quart pail: 1.25 lbs. gross.

#### Approximate Coverage

250-300 ft2 per quart.

# **Equipment**

Stainless steel trowel with rounded corners and beveled edges.

#### **Surface Preparation**

Venetian plaster finishes shall be fully dry and cured prior to application of Ceraplus.

# **Application Instructions**

Trowel apply the material in a thin even coat using random short strokes. If a gloss finish is desired, burnish immediately with trowel. Additional burnishing increases gloss. Do not overburnish.

#### **Properties**

Initial set in 1 hour, cure in 72 hours, at 70°F and 50% RH.

## **Benefits**

Water based; environmentally safe; vapor permeable; moisture resistant, grease resistant; adds durability in baths and kitchens.

# Limitations

Skilled application required; not compatible with solvent based products or cleaners; apply in temperatures between 60°F and 85°F; protect face and eyes; use in well ventilated areas; for use on interior wall and ceiling surfaces only; do not mix with other products.

# Maintenance

To clean, use a soft sponge or damp cloth and a mild soap and water solution.

# Warranty

10 years material warranty against delamination.
